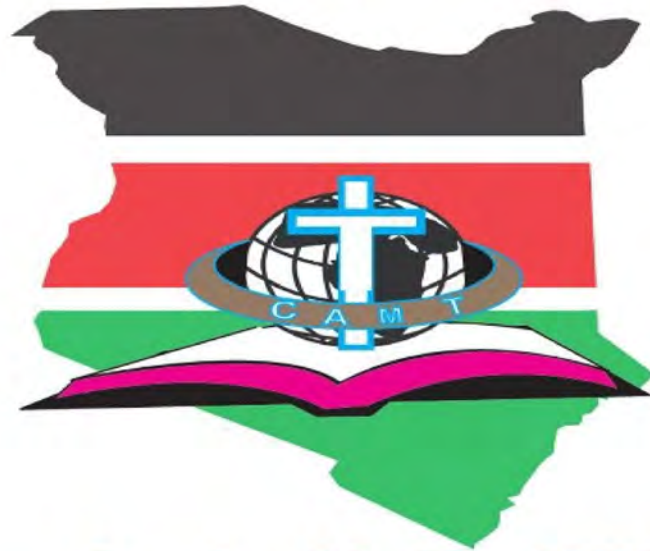

CAMT-KENYA BRIEF HISTORY

- ▶ Christ Ambassadors Mission Team of Kenya was started by a group of 15 young devoted Christians on August 21, 2006 at ACK St. Barnabas Church Kavengero in Embu county Kenya.
- ▶ we evangelized with the first 15 youth who had accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour and we empowered many other youths for mission through discipleship classes.

- ▶ Many youth were evangelized and joined the other 15 and became 35. This group has been growing each year and has now recruited members from other denominations for fellowships, singing, Global community development volunteer programs, Missions and worship.

 - ▶ Members of the Mission Team are pastors from different denominations and different counties, students in Public Universities, colleges, high schools, Military men and women from various African communities and middle schools as well.

CAMT-KENYA CHILDREN MINISTRY



- ▶ CAMT-KENYA has children program and among the children in the program we have identified 40 needy children who either lack basic needs or do not have parents but live with their grandparents in the poor homes. This number is growing day by day. We carry out discipleship program and mentorship to various churches and NGOs AND institutions dealing with children where we aim at transforming the lives of children into a responsible Godly young generation.
- ▶ The mission Team visits these children at churches, homes and schools where they share with them the Love of Christ and his words.
- ▶ In August 2013, CAMT-KENYA launched their dream to build a home for orphans and a kindergarten class. Each Child needs USD. 80 per month for food, clothes, school fees and books. On 14th February 2016 CAMT-KENYA conducted a child evangelism at ACK. ST.BARNABAS CHURCH IN MBEERE NORTH EMBU COUNTY KENYA WHERE WE DONATED BIBLES,SANITARY TOWELS,BOOKS AND CHILDREN READING MATERIALS TO 270 CHILDREN. We also did deworming to children for better health.

WATER SCARCITY

- ▶ CAMT-KENYA has a dream to participate in reducing the problem of water in Mbeere. Most of the people in our community walk 5-7KMS to look for water at the nearby rivers. The rivers in Mbeere are Tana, Thuci, Ena and Thiba which are more than 20KM apart.
- ▶ Our dream is to partner with friends all over the world to help provide water tanks and dig out some wells for our people to tap water during rainy season.
- ▶ Children and Youth are the most hit by this problem because they are asked by parents to go for water. There is also risk in the rivers because a number of children have been killed by crocodiles.

MISSION CHALLENGES

- ▶ Our Mission Team borrows Musical instruments from other churches in order to go out and preach. If the team can have Electric Piano , Amplifier, PPT Projector, Video Camera, Musical drums and band it would be easy to do mission and evangelism activity.
- ▶ Our Mission Team have challenge of sponsoring trainings and workshops for the youth. Every April ,August and December we hold youth trainings and conferences but we are not able to support those youths who attend with some basic needs like food, study materials and accommodation.
- ▶ If we can have support by churches in developed countries we could facilitate the growth and expansion of our mission team in the community.
- ▶ Office equipments: We have began opening new offices in Embu Town and other major towns in every county as our satellites for easy out reach. In these satellites we look forward to training our youth computer studies, life skills, leadership skills, talent fostering, english and Swahili Languages, Health and counselling education. We require much support to buy notebook or desktop computers and literature materials like video machine and PPT Projector for training.
- ▶ Because of health for our youth and the 40 orphans, we would like to launch a pharmacy shop where our trained health worker/CAMT-KENYA Rescue Team can facilitate our community with drugs like malaria tablets and first aid kit.
